The **iRead Institutional Report** is a tool designed to provide a comprehensive view of iRead usage and learning progress across the entire institution.

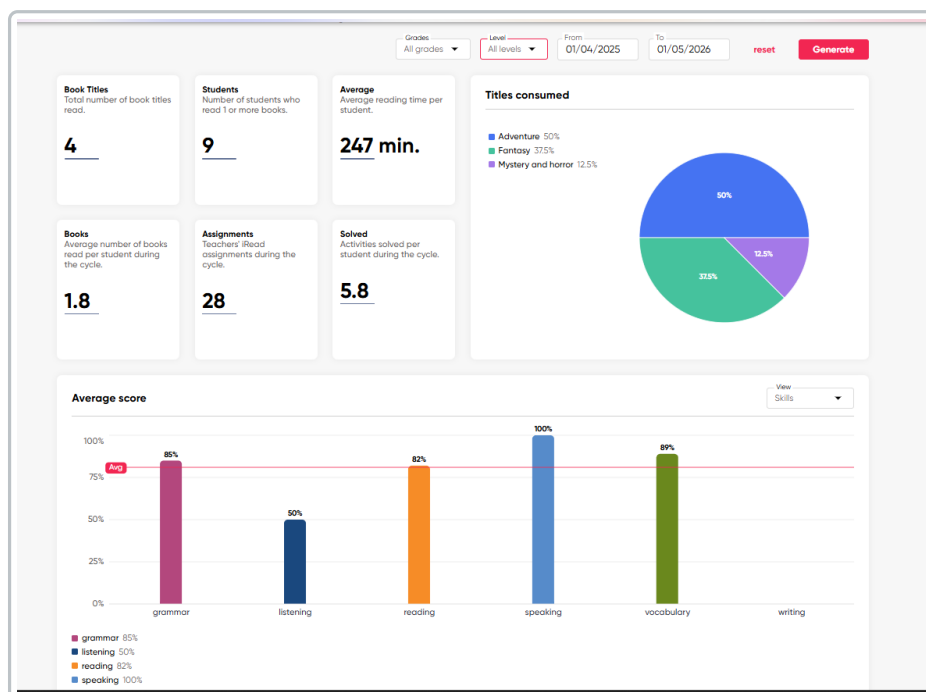
This report now includes the option to **download a PDF version**, aligning with the behavior of other reports within the platform.

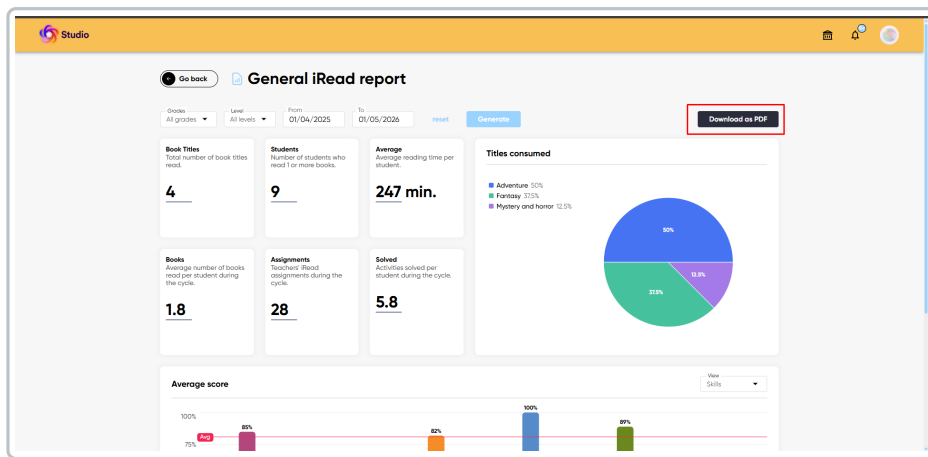
What can you do?

Validation when creating a new institution

Now, when creating an institution in Studio, a key improvement has been introduced in how form errors are handled.

What's changed?

- The general error banner for empty fields has been removed, avoiding unnecessary interruptions.
- Validation messages are now displayed directly below each field, clearly indicating what information is missing or needs correction.
- Unnecessary support-related actions are avoided when required fields are incomplete, making the process faster and more efficient.

Error on modals

Now, error messages that appear during actions within modal windows are correctly displayed **on top of the modal**, ensuring a clear interaction without interference.

What's changed?

- Error messages are no longer hidden behind the modal window.
- When interacting with the message, clicks are correctly registered on the error itself.
- Accidental closing of the modal is prevented, eliminating confusion.

What does this mean for you?

A smoother and more predictable experience, where every action behaves exactly as expected, without unexpected interruptions.

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Clear confirmation when replying to messages

The experience of replying to messages has been optimized to ensure clarity at all times.

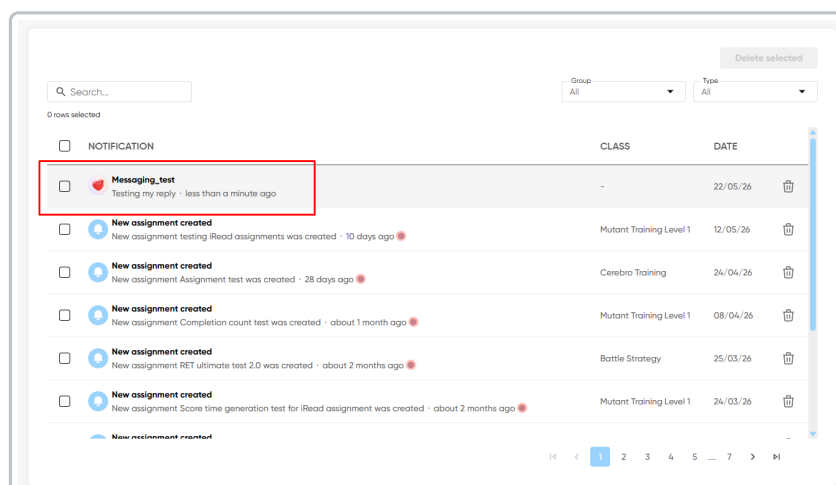
Previously, when a response was sent, there was no visible confirmation: the interface did not update, and the window remained open, which could make it seem like the action had not been completed, causing confusion.

What's improved now?

- An immediate visual confirmation is shown after sending a response.
- The interface updates automatically to reflect the change.

What does this mean for you?

A clearer interaction, without doubts or unnecessary repetitions, allowing you to reply to messages smoothly and with complete confidence.



Full visibility of replies in forums



An issue that prevented all replies within comments from being displayed has been resolved. In some cases, even when multiple replies existed (for example, 5), only a few were shown, disrupting the continuity of conversations.

What's improved now?

- Full visibility of all replies within each comment is ensured.
- Forum discussions now accurately reflect the complete participation of both students and teachers.

What does this mean for you?

You can now follow conversations without missing important information, enabling a more complete, transparent, and collaborative interaction.

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User level editing

An issue affecting data updates when editing a user has been resolved.

Previously, when modifying a user's information, the **level was not being sent correctly**, preventing the change from being saved and reflected in the platform.

What's improved now?

- The **level field is now properly sent and saved** when editing a user.
- Information is updated consistently across the platform.
- Data loss and profile discrepancies are prevented.

What does this mean for you?

You can now manage user levels with confidence, ensuring that changes are reflected immediately and accurately.

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Notification indicator

The issue that prevented the notification bell from appearing as active, even when there were pending messages to review, has been fixed. This could give the impression that there were no new notifications, affecting the visibility of communication.

What's improved now?

- The notification bell correctly reflects when there are unread messages.

- It is accurately synchronized with real platform activity.
- A reliable and consistent visual alert is ensured.

What does this mean for you?

You will receive a clear and timely signal whenever there are new notifications.

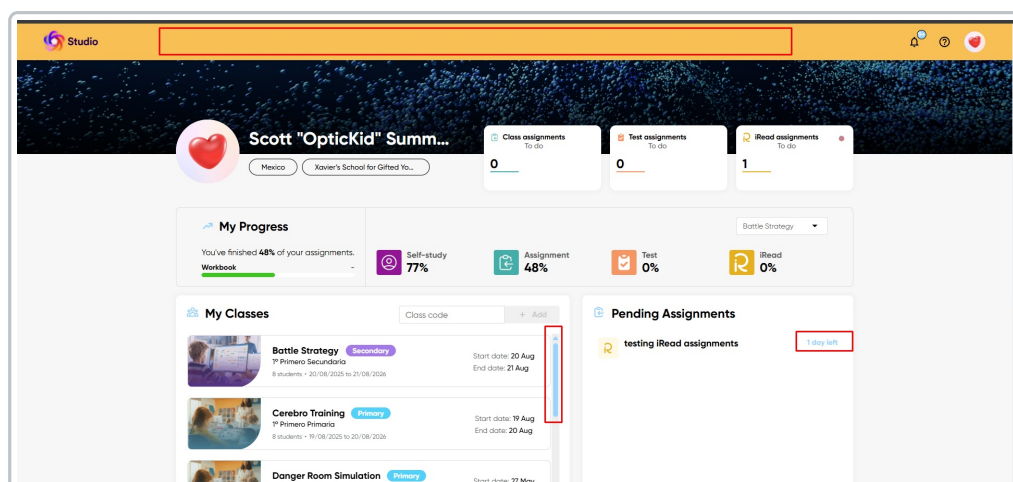
The **Theme Maker in Studio** is a tool designed to help you create, preview, and customize personalized themes.

Diagnostic Report

The **Institutional Diagnostic Test Report** has been optimized to ensure that all data is fully aligned with your selected filters.

From now on, when selecting a specific time period, **all displayed information** —including charts and exports—

corresponds exactly to the chosen range.

What's improved now?

- Charts display only the data from the selected period.
- The exported CSV file maintains full consistency with the applied filters.
- Any discrepancies between on-screen data and downloaded reports have been eliminated.

What does this mean for you?

More reliable and consistent analysis, enabling you to make decisions based on accurate and properly segmented data.



Test scheduling control

The scheduling configuration for test-type tasks has been improved to prevent inconsistencies when adjusting dates and times.

Previously, when modifying the end time using keyboard arrows, it was possible to set a time **earlier than the start time**, resulting in invalid configurations and potential confusion.

What's improved now?

- End time is now validated to always be **later than the start time**.
- Invalid configurations are restricted when adjusting time with the keyboard.
- Overall consistency in date and time selection within the modal has been improved.

What does this mean for you?

A more secure and logical setup process, preventing accidental errors and ensuring tasks are scheduled correctly from the start.

Unlimited calendars for better planning

The calendar functionality has been improved to support more complete and flexible academic planning.

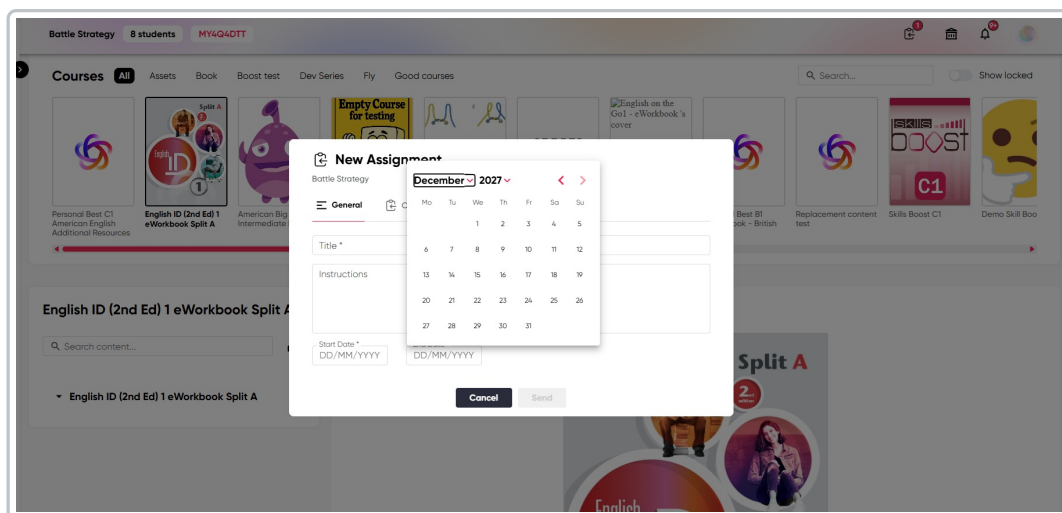
Previously, when creating classes or scheduling tasks, the calendar limited date selection up to **December 31, 2026**, which made it difficult to organize full school cycles and plan ahead.

What's improved now?

- The available date range in calendars has been extended.
- You can now **create classes and schedule tasks beyond 2026** without restrictions.
- A limitation that affected long-term academic planning has been removed.

What does this mean for you?

Greater flexibility to organize full academic cycles, prepare content in advance, and manage learning without time constraints.



Login loading

Previously, when accessing the platform, the screen could remain blank for several seconds, creating uncertainty about whether the system was loading correctly.

What's improved now?

- A loading indicator or visible login screen is displayed while access is being processed.
- The blank screen has been removed, avoiding confusion.
- The perceived speed and stability of the platform have been improved.

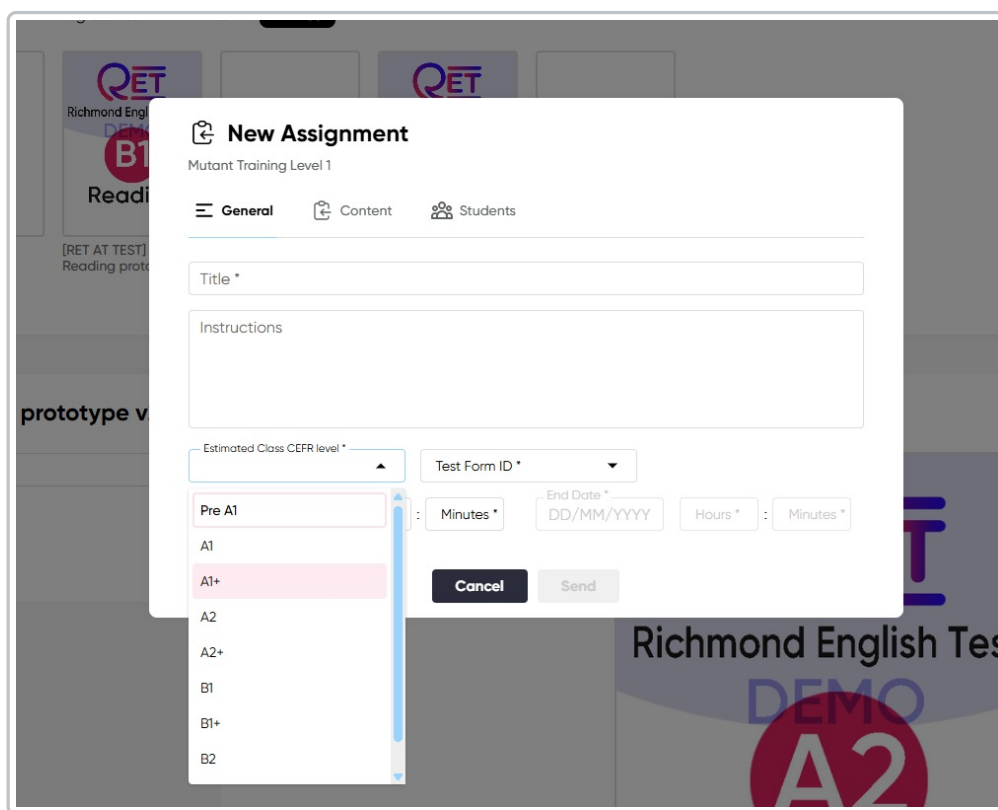

Visual fix in class student modal

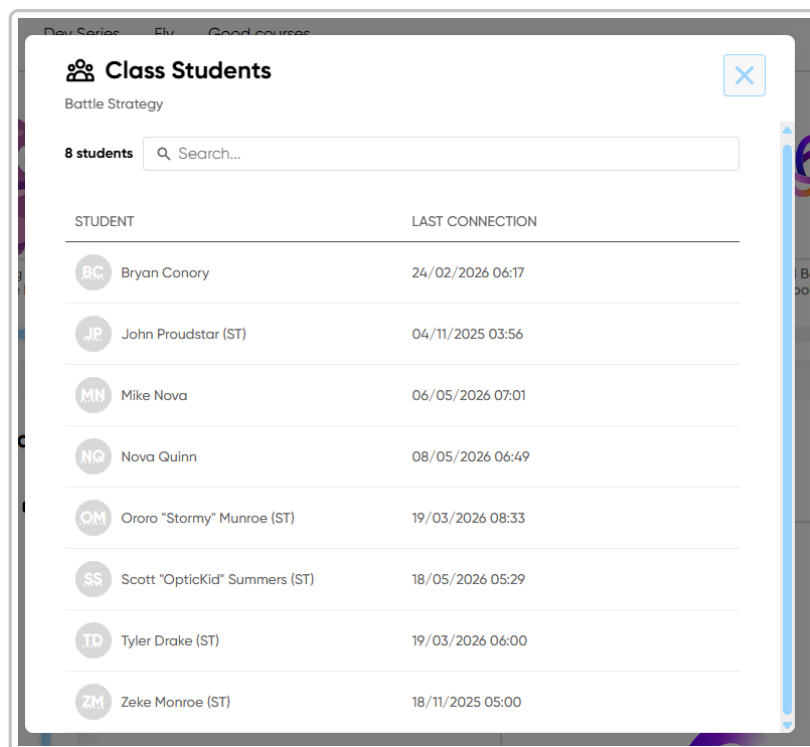
A visual issue in the **class student modal** has been fixed, which previously affected the clarity and proper display of information.

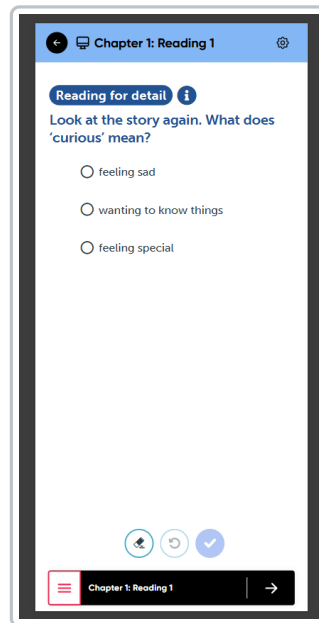
What's improved now?

- Keep the focus on the main content without distracting elements.

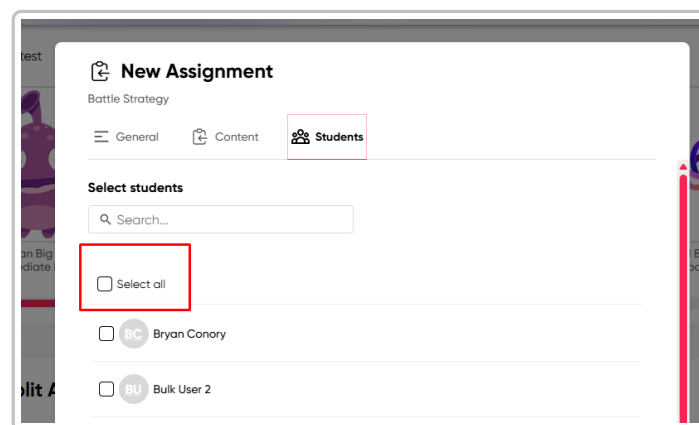
What does this mean for you?
